Please read the following before completing entry forms. Entries must be on the official entry form of the show. If additional entry forms are needed, either photocopy the form included herein, contact the show manager or secretary, or visit the WAHA website (www.wisconsinarabian.com). All horses belonging to one owner must be entered on one entry form. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form per show. Farm name may not be used unless the stable or farm is the bona fide owner appearing on the registration papers, or the stable or farm name as been registered with USEF, and number is noted in the space provided. A copy of your USEF Farm Registration Certificate should accompany your entry. Every owner, trainer, exhibitor, rider, driver, and handler must sign the entry form in the spaces provided. If the owner and trainer are the same, owner must sign in both spaces.

### When Making Entries Be Sure to include the items listed below.

Required Entry Information: No packets will be given if entries are not complete.

- 1. A copy of the registration paper showing proof of ownership and registration for each horse being entered. Any Farm or Entity owning and showing a horse must be a member of AHA, and that membership number must be on the entry form. For leases see AHA Handbook.
- 2. Negative Coggins test results from the current calendar year (2017) for all horses entered. The original results or an official health certificate with the date of the Coggins test must be presented at the Show Office for verification.
- Copies of AHA Competition membership cards of each owner, trainer, driver, rider, handler and agent or trainer or pay \$35 per person AHA Single Event Membership fee. Walk Trot and Leadline riders are exempt.
- 4. Copies of USEF membership cards for each owner, lessee, rider, driver, handler and agent or trainer or pay \$30 non-member fee. All exhibitors showing in ATR/JTR classes must have their own USEF membership number. Walk Trot and Leadline riders are exempt.
- 5. Junior exhibitors are considered amateurs and may enter junior classes and/or amateur classes.
- 6. Dressage riders: Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, USEF) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
- 7. A signed check made payable to WAHA covering all fees. Entries received without full payment of all fees will be considered postentries. No post dated checks.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 8. Physical Inspection: All animals are subject to a physical inspection at no charge by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show committee as a safeguard against communicable diseases. Any horse who exhibits questionable symptoms must be immediately removed from the show grounds. Examination or treatment not requested by show officials shall be on a private practice basis.
- 9. Liability: All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Wisconsin Arabian Horse Association, Region 10, and/or the Jefferson County Fair Park will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any kind of article. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal, or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the WAHA Board against any and all loss, including damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
- 10. Attendants/Grooms/Headers: No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants, and show officials. Attendants, grooms, and/or headers may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. Headers will be permitted in all driving classes.
- 11. Halter Classes: Horses in breeding and in-hand classes will enter the ring in a pre-determined, randomly assigned order to be established by show management. Products may not be applied to hoof or hide to conceal a conformation defect. Clear or transparent products may be used on hooves for Breeding or In-Hand classes. Each horse must be present at the in-gate and ready to enter the ring when its number is called. Any horse not present and ready to enter the ring will not be admitted to the class. (Exception: Sport Horse In-Hand Entries with conflicts with main show ring)
- 12. Warm-Up Facilities & Competition Arenas: On Friday, Saturday, and Sunday the two indoor arenas will be available for warm up. Arenas: Indoor 80' x 150'; North ring 115' x 225'; West ring 150' x 250' with sand footing.
- 13. Stallions: PB and HA stallions may be shown by ladies or junior exhibitors in any class except Walk-Trot, Showmanship and Leadline classes. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian stallions two years or over may compete in performance classes.
- 14. Class Size: The show committee reserves the right to split any class with duplicate awards presented.
- 15. Call for Classes: The two-minute rule will be strictly enforced. If time is needed for a tack change, the gate must be notified. All tack changes must be made at the ring entrance.
- 16. PA System: Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system, no protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed on the basis of a PA system problem.
- 17. Pets: Pets will be allowed on the grounds but must be on a leash. Pet owners are required to supply an official rabies vaccination certificate showing date of vaccination and serum used.
- 18. Electrical Connections: Must meet all current local, state, and national electrical codes. All cable must be three or four wire cable for connection to existing outlets. All connections must be properly grounded. Electrical cords must not run through hay, straw, or any other bedding. Cords will not be allowed in or crossing an aisle. The Show Manager will be advised of all violations and will notify the offender. If the violation is not remedied within four hours, or if it is the second violation, power will be cut off to the individual exhibitor.
- 19. Overnight Camping: Overnight camping facilities are available with electric and water hookup priced per night depending on the service required. Payment of the camping fee is made to WAHA at the time of check in, and the Fair Park office will issue a camping permit that must be displayed in the window.
- 20. Stalls: Permanent stalls with stall fronts will be available at the show. Tack stalls may be limited at the discretion of show management. Each horse must be assigned a separate stall (except mares with suckling foals). Stalls will be available noon, Thursday, August 27th, 2016. Early arrival permitted at an additional \$20 per horse. Showing from a trailer is not permitted. No smoking in the barns will be strictly enforced
- 21. Bedding and Hay: No bedding will be provided as part of the stall fee. Bedding will be available for sale at the show for \$9/bag. No grain, pellets, or hay will be for sale

- 22. Stall Assignments: Stalls are limited. Therefore, stall assignments will be made on a first come, first served basis based on the following:
  - a) Members of the WAHA Show Committee.
  - b) Class sponsors paid/US government postmarked before entry closing date.
  - c) Stalls paid in order of US government postmark date. Paid stall orders with the same postmark date will be assigned in inverse order to the number of PAID stalls per order whenever possible. Show Management may exercise discretion in regard to stabling placement. Metered postmarks are not acceptable.
- 23. No Shows: There will be a \$5 penalty assessed for "no shows." If you have entered a class and are not going to show in that class, you must notify the Show Office and gate before that class enters the ring or pay a \$5 penalty/class. There will be NO REFUND for No Shows.
- 24. Open Checks: No "open" checks will be accepted for pre-entry fees or stall reservations. All pre-entries and stall reservations must be accompanied by fully completed, negotiable checks dated on or before the close of entries date. Entries received without such checks will be returned.
- 25. NSF Check Policy: There is a \$50 penalty for each check returned due to non-sufficient funds. In addition, either of the following may result in termination of personal and/or business check privileges in payment for any charges to WAHA shows or to WAHA for any other charges (including but not limited to dues and/or fees for WAHA programs): 1. Failure to fully and promptly pay for entries, fees, stabling, and related items (including but not limited to such things as hay, grain, camping, electrical hookups, services, dues, programs, or any other show expense) or for any other WAHA expenses (such as dues and/or fees for WAHA programs; and/or 2. Presenting two NSF checks to WAHA in any one calendar year.
- 26. Hoof Length, Shoes and Pads: Management reserves the right to request measurement of toe length, shoe dimensions, and remove shoes and/or pads for hoof inspection of any and all horses in any class. Shoes may be pulled and inspected at random.
- 27. Printing Errors: The Show Committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Corrections of any error will be posted in the Show Office.
- 28. Refunds: Stall fees and office fees will not be refunded under any circumstance. Entry fees for entries cancelled before the official closing date for pre-entries will be returned. Refunds of entry fees will be made after the closing date for pre-entries upon presentation of a Veterinarian's Certificate to the Show Secretary by the end of the last of the class of the show. No refunds will be made thereafter.
- 29. USEF STATEMENT: LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.
- 30. Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 31. Discipline: Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the above listed from the show without being liable for compensation or damages (GR 702). Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, federation steward, technical delegate or show veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. GR702 & GR703
- 32. AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)
- 33. Health Papers/Coggins Test: An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Wisconsin. A negative Coggins certificate issued within the 2017 calendar year must accompany all horses. The health and original Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check in.

USEF GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

- 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinesions; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
- 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.

<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or
  dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions
  (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also
  exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
  identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

#### Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

#### How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form and fax or mail it to the USDF office.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are
  open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

#### ATTENTION DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (USDF and USEF) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

### **ACTS (Arabian Community Tournament Show)**

#### INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential new owners to the joys of showing and riding Arabian horses by giving beginning riders of any breed an opportunity to gain experience by offering beginner classes at our Arabian horse shows.

#### **RIDERS**

- Riders are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program (NOT REQUIRED).
- Encouraged but not required to be a member of AHA.
- Riding suits and chaps are not allowed.
- Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate.
- · A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested.
- A riding helmet is also mandatory for riders 18 and under and suggested for all ages.
- Appropriate footwear with a small heel is mandatory.
- Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter into any non-academy riding classes, and are ineligible to compete in ACT classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a non-ACT or non-Academy show.

#### **HORSES**

- Horses are encouraged to be lesson horses of any breed and should display the characteristics of such, but it is not mandatory that they are
  utilized in a professional lesson—all horses are welcome, as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition.
- A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used.
- Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, tie down martingales
  are not allowed.

Any horse or rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules may be eliminated by the horse show management.

Horses can cross enter in ANY ACT classes, but riders may not cross enter between the Walk/Trot Pleasure, Walk/Trot Equitation, or the Walk/Trot/Canter classes.

ACT entries are to follow horse show rules but are not AHA or USEF sanctioned classes.

Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

#### **JUDGING**

All ACT classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage, and upon the riding skills of the rider.

Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner.

Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement.

Headers are allowed in the line-up in all walk-trot classes.

HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

Horsemanship Pleasure is meant to differ from the equitation class in that it is judged more on the rider's ability to display their horse to its best advantage, communicating to the judge through their horsemanship and riding abilities that the horse is a pleasure to ride and can be guided and set up to show to its best advantage
